

**ELYSIAN CITY COUNCIL
WORKSHOP WITH
MN DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
MARCH 27, 2018**

The Elysian City Council held a Workshop Meeting with representatives of MnDOT on Tuesday, March 27, 2018 at City Hall at 6:00 pm.

Roll Call: Mayor Clinton Stoen; Councilmembers Robert Houlihan, Tom McBroom, Mary Opsahl, and Dennis Schnoor. Absent: City Administrator Lorri Kopischke and Public Works Director Ron Greenwald.

Also Present: Multiple MnDOT District 7 Representatives including: Forrest Hasty, PE, Project Manager; Brett Paasch, PE – Traffic Engineer; and Shauna McIntire – Grad Engineer.

Forrest Hasty, PE – Project Engineer, MnDOT District 7, provided a recap of the process and meetings on this project that had occurred to date. The latest design which included medians, turn lanes and included the closing of several accesses had been presented to the public at the March 7, 2018 Open House. At that meeting, the public expressed several concerns regarding access, turn radius, and public safety. Hasty stated that the major concerns have been considered and addressed. Hasty then presented a revised drawing which addressed some of the issues. The turn radius at 5th Street has been widened, a separate access to the car wash was added, 2nd Street SE was changed to a right in / right out and the intersection at Main Street East and Highway 60 was adjusted to provide a better sightline.

A future Open House Meeting will be scheduled to present this updated design to the public. Hasty would like the City Council to take a vote on the final design of the project shortly after the next Open House Meeting.
